Our History

Blood-n-Fire Alaska started in 2005 as an outreach at "Land and Cabins" where we delivered small bags of food and love to the residents there on a weekly basis. We called the outreach "Treasure Box" because of the hidden treasures we found living in those cabins.

Over the years we have been part of helping families throughout the Mat-Su Valley with food, clothing, shelter and advocacy to see the marginalized and broken come to stability and independence.

As of 2018 Blood-n-Fire serves 700 families a month with food and clothing supplies.

In 2015 Blood-n-Fire ventured into transitional living opening the Knik House Transitional Living Program. We implement a Christ centered, life transformation model designed to successfully rehabilitate people, bringing to health and stability. Once again, we saw the blessing of God, Knik House is now in 2 locations serving 35 plus individuals working hard to overcome any barriers that hold them back.

Knik House

Knik House is a transitional living program Located in the Mat-Su Valley.

The purpose of the Knik House is to provide safe transitional/supportive housing and social services to homeless and at-risk individuals.

Knik House is much more than a homeless shelter. Residents of our program must be willing to work hard at becoming stable, healthy and independent. This includes setting personal goals and working to complete those goals.

While in Knik House programming you will receive training in life skills, work skills and relational skills

Homeless Prevention

Through a coalition of 7 agencies we offer assistance with a wide array of needs: utilities about to be shut off, heating fuel, imminent evictions, first months rental assistance, gas cards...
