This Phase begins when the applicant is ready to look for full time employment. It can be a struggle when looking for work, getting hired, and then keeping a Job. This 3 week program, offers tools, practical work place experience, and many volunteer opportunities for individuals to make some connections with their community by using God's Plan of Work.

To live as Sarah's House ladies must be physically and mentally able and willing to obtain employment.

God's Work Design helps with filing out employment applications, creating resumes, mock interviews, online job search and applications, writing a cover letter, and volunteering and job shadowing. employment.

Foundations-2nd Phase:

Connect Palmer is a faith based, Christ Center Program. During the Foundation's Phase the resident at Sarah's House will be completing several Bible Studies both in house and at local churches.

During this time any drug and alcohol abuse assessment is required and any treatment needed will be done during this phase.

A volunteer mentor is assigned and the mentor meets with them weekly and helps the resident with setting goals, tracking progress, time management, and later in Phase 4, they help with budgeting and an Exit Plan.

The resident will be participating in local volunteerism and/or part time work depending on their level of skill

and time needed for treatment plans.

When the resident is ready to begin the search for full time employment, they will move into Phase 3: God's Work Design.

LIFE Connect: Phase 4:



This Phase begins when resident has obtained full time employment. Our Life Skills Program has matched

up the applicant with a volunteer mentor. This mentor has helped them during the Foundations Phase and is now ready to help with budgeting and an Exit Plan. The Exit Plan that will Address finances (by creating budgets for a minimum of 4 pay checks) and look at transportation options, housing opportunities, and creating a moving out Support Circle.


In the first year of offering the God's
