

A few things to **REMEMBER**

1. CHILDREN

For their safety, children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult and remain with that person at all times. This includes inside and outside our facility.

2. ANIMALS

No animals of any type may be inside the building, with the exception of Service Dogs. All animals must be on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your animals outside. If you need a bag to remove waste, please ask a volunteer and they will assist you.

3. LINE-UP

Please do not line up before 10am. We open the doors at 10:30 and will sign you in. Do not save a line place for yourself or others by placing a box.

4. FOOD

You may shop for groceries once per week, either Thursday or Friday. You may attend the Café every time we are open. You may not take a plate from the café home; we are a dine-in only establishment.

5. BEHAVIOR

We ask that you behave in a manner consistent with a public setting. This means no cursing, fighting, or any other behavior generally unacceptable for public.

6. SMOKING

Smoking is only permitted in the designated smoking area. Please dispose of butts in the bucket provided.

7. PARKING

Parking is at the front of the building only.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What do I need to bring to receive services?

All you need is a valid ID.

Is there a volunteering requirement?

No, but you are welcome to join us in serving our community! It is up to you to decide how often or if you would like to volunteer. You can volunteer once, once a week, once a month, even once a year. We are flexible and try to accommodate everyone's schedule.

How often can I get a food box?

You may pick up a box of food once per week, on Thursday or Friday.

How often can I eat at the Café?

We are open for meals Wednesday night at 6pm, and Thursday and Friday 10:30am-12:45pm. Come every time we are open if you like-we look forward to serving you!

Do you deliver locally?

Unfortunately at this time we do not have the capability to deliver. You must be present to receive all of our offered services.

Can someone else pick up a box for me?

We strive to be good stewards of the donations we receive. For this reason and to be able to distribute to as many families as possible, we require you to be present to receive groceries from Frontline Mission.

What do I do if I have any issues?

If you have any issues, please inform the front desk volunteer, or if they are unavailable, any volunteer will be able to help you.

Frontline Café:

Enjoy a fresh, hot meal in a friendly café setting.

Thursday meal: 10:30 am – 12:45 pm at the Mission building

Friday meal: 10:30 am – 12:45 pm at the Mission building

Frontline Closet:

A volunteer will assist you in choosing clothing and process requests for hygiene products. Check back weekly, as we receive new items often.

Frontline Food Distribution:

Shop for food on Thursday or Friday, 10:30 am – 1:00 pm. We will escort patrons through the Food Distribution Center as they pick out their groceries.

Shower & Laundry Room:

By appointment only – sign up for a shower and get the clothing you wear in washed while you wait in our newly renovated Shower & Laundry Waiting Room.
