Funded by HHS, they have Federal PHS deemed status for health-related claims.

Description

Alaska's Donated Dental Services (DDS) offers dental care to individuals who <u>unable to afford</u> the costs, and meet <u>one</u> of these criteria: <u>being</u> over 65, permanently disabled, or requiring medically necessary dental care.

The program, run by volunteer dentists, provides comprehensive treatment but excludes emergency and cosmetic services. Veterans who qualify are encouraged to apply, even from counties not currently accepting new participants.

urgent or complex dental need. Payment is out-of-pocket at deeply discounted rates, insurance is not accepted.

Services: Discounted dental treatments including cleanings, periodontal therapy, and fillings in an educational setting.

Exclusive Requirements: Patients must be willing to undergo longer appointments (3-4 hours) with students.

Alaska's Donated Dental Services (DDS) Program

Summary: Ideal for seniors and disabled individuals with financial constraints. Not for those seeking Emergency or aesthetic

dental solutions

Services: Full dental treatment by qualified volunteers for eligible participants.

Exclusive Requirements: Must be aged 65+, or have a disability, or in need of essential dental care and unable to afford costs.
